INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

From on or about December 22, 2005, through on or about the date of this Indictment, in Broward, Palm Beach, and Miami-Dade Counties, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

**ARTHUR VANMOOR,**

did willfully and knowingly disobey and resist a lawful order of a Court of the United States, that is, the Temporary Restraining Order issued by the Honorable Joan A. Lenard, United States District Judge, on December 22, 2005, in the case of United States of America v. Arthur Vanmoor, et al., Case No. 05-61940-CIV-LENARD/KLEIN (S.D. Fla.), by operating multiple Internet websites advertising and promoting Cancer Control, Migraine Miracle, Flu Fighter, and other non-FDA-approved "new drugs" and "misbranded" drugs, and by shipping and selling Cancer Control and other non-FDA-approved new drugs and misbranded drugs, all of which activities were prohibited by the Temporary Restraining Order, and such acts were of such character as to constitute also

criminal offenses under the laws of the United States, to wit, wire fraud, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1343; mail fraud, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1341; introducing into interstate commerce “misbranded” drugs, as that term is defined at Title 21, United States Code, Section 352, and non-FDA-approved “new drugs,” as that term is defined at Title 21, United States Code, Section 321(p), in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 331(a) and (d);

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 402 and 2.
